Good Morning-

Beginning tomorrow, Tuesday December 1st, The JHH ED will now carry famotidine (Pepcid®) as our H2- Receptor Antagonist of choice. Famotidine will replace ranitidine on the JHH formulary.

Famotidine is now an orderable item in EPIC, and will replace ranitidine in order sets in EPIC as well. This change is a result of our harmonization efforts with JH-Bayview EPIC ASAP build.

Injectable Famotidine may be administered IV Push: Max of 40 mg diluted in 10 mL of NS over 2 minutes (ref: PATO30 Adult IV Push List), or may be diluted and administered over 15-30 min
